## What is fiscal sponsorship?

Fiscal sponsorship is a practice that has evolved as an effective and efficient means of starting new charitable initiatives or delivering public services. Partnership for Child Health is a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization that provides a home for individuals or groups that do not have tax-exempt status but want to seek funding for a project or program. Many donors—foundations, corporations and government agencies—require tax-exempt status in order to be eligible to receive funding. Partnership for Child Health provides this; and also offers management of the many financial and administrative responsibilities related to a grant or other award so the individual or group can focus on their program.

## Who can apply for fiscal sponsorship?

To be eligible to apply to Partnership for Child Health for fiscal sponsorship, your project must reflect a commitment to goals which are aligned with the Partnership's mission—which is to improve the health and wellbeing of children and youth in Northeast Florida, especially those with special health care needs
